### **Ski Club**

Are you interested in making new friends and improving your skiing abilities? Join the Clear Lake Ski Club. Our summer kick-off meeting is Saturday, May 25 from 5-7pm at the Yacht Club. Our regular meetings are June 1, 8, 15, 22, and 29 and July 6, 13, and 20 starting at 10am. We plan to practice after (and sometimes before) most meetings. You can showcase your talents during our annual ski show on July 27. Open to kids ages 18 and under. Membership cost is \$25 per kid. A CLYC membership is required.

**Sailing Camp:** Camp is open to kids ages 7 to 16, limited to 16 students per camp. Enrollment will be open to Clear Lake Yacht Club members and their family members until June 1st. Enrollment will then open to the public. Camp is \$50 per student.
