We owe a big THANK YOU to the four coaches: Bob Grimes, George Schenkel, Jack Sanderson, and Jim Grant. Isaiah Grant also

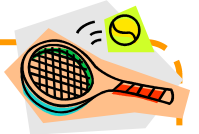
served as "student coach" with his injured ankle.
