There are dates available if you wish to host or help on a committee. Contact

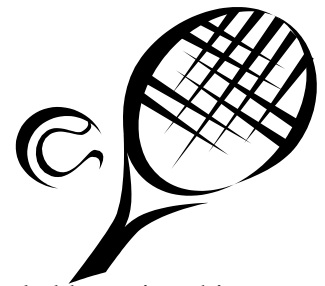
