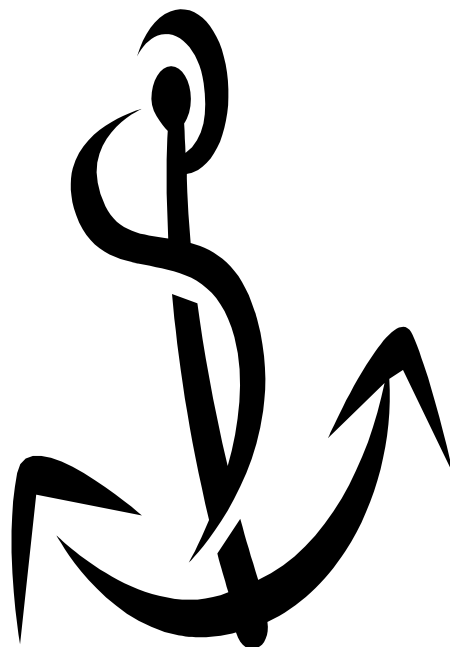
FROM THE SECRETARY
