
#### **Capital Campaign and New Property Updates**

When we launched the capital campaign last July, we set an ambitious goal of \$800,000. 75% of that was needed by Christmas to ensure that we met the seller's deadline for buying the adjacent lot. Due to the incredible generosity of the membership, we exceeded those goals. At last count, total funds raised amounted to \$947,000! I cannot thank everyone enough for your contribution to the Club's future and legacy.

We closed on the land at the turn of the year. At time of writing, we are finalizing the administrative process required by the Town to combine the new and original lot. We plan to stabilize the lot with some minor regrading and topsoil/seeding whilst the site planning process proceeds. A tentative goal is to start any agreed construction work in fall.

The Property Development Committee is leading the planning effort and will be workshopping ideas later in the spring, building on input received via the property survey collected in the fall. If you would like to be involved, please contact Mike Kellermeier. Look for further communication on the subject as the season progresses. A copy of the survey responses can be found on the Club website in the documents section.

Thank you, and let me know if you need anything else. Barring cancellations, the calendar for music is set and has been added to the ClubExpress calendar.




#### **SAILING NEWS**


