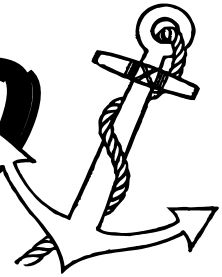

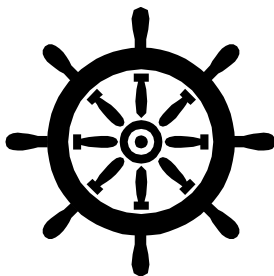
### Final Commodore's Notes

## **Ski Club:**

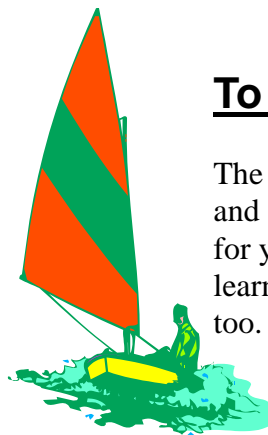
The first meeting of the ski club will be held June 3, 2006. If you are interested in joining in the fun, mark your calendar and plan to attend.

### **The Cochran Award:**

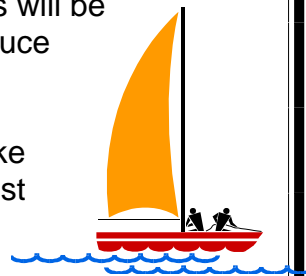
